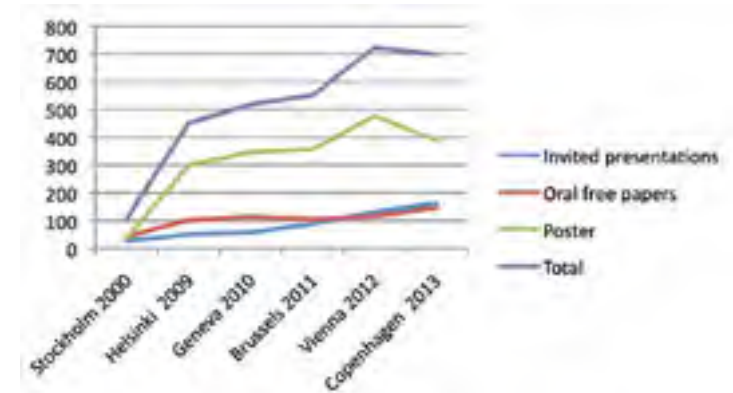
In recent years, this has led to EWMA's involvement in several EU-funded projects and worldwide collaborations with other stakeholders, all aimed at developing and implementing treatment recommendations and guidelines.

Milestones

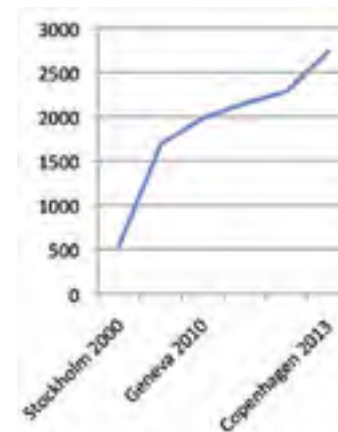
Year	Milestone
1991	EWMA founded. First EWMA conference.
2000	CAP Partner arranges EWMA conference for the first time. Now it is one of the primary wound conferences in the world.
2001	EWMA secretariat established in Copenhagen. First EWMA position document published. Since then, various aspects of wound management have been covered. First issue of the EWMA Journal published. Now 12.000 copies are distributed to clinicians throughout Europe. EWMA cooperating organisation model established. This network now includes 48 organisations in 36 countries.
2003	First EWMA Wound Education Curriculum developed.
2007	EWMA University Conference Model pilot established. The EWMA conference is now an integrated part of wound management student education.
2008	EWMA course endorsement programme established. Collaboration with Eucomed Advanced Wound Care Sector Group on defining the "burden of illness" associated with chronic wounds in Europe. EWMA <i>Patient Outcome Group</i> established. The objective: to examine the challenges related to acquiring high quality evidence in wound care.
2012	First meeting of the EWMA Teacher Network. EWMA became part of the 'SWAN-iCare' project (EU FP7). EWMA became part of the 'United4Health' project (EU FP).
